LANGUAGE GAMES



I'M THINKING (JE PENSE A)

Je pense à un pays qui commence par B. (I'm thinking of a country beginning with B)
Je pense à un pays qui commence par I (I'm thinking of a country beginning with I)
 The children try to guess which town or country you are thinking of, eg **Belgique, Inde.**

THE HUMAN LINE

Give children names of countries on card.
 When you clap your hands, they have to put themselves into an alphabetical order.

THE SIX CORNERS

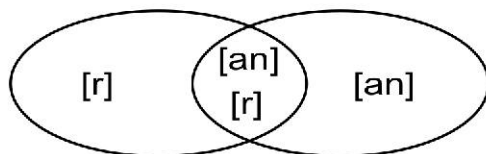
Place six cards in 6 different parts of the room.
 Children are in the middle and go to the right flashcards when you name one of continents:
Je vais en Amérique du Nord. (I am going to North America)

FRENCH SPEAKING COUNTRIES BOARD GAME (JEU DES PAYS FRANCOPHONES)

Children roll a die and move forward.
 When they land on a square with an instruction, they follow that instruction.
 If they land on a number, they have to name a French speaking country for an even number, any other country for an odd number.
J'habite en Côte d'Ivoire. (I live in Ivory Coast) **J'habite en Chine.** (I live in China)

LE CERCLE DES SONS (CIRCLE OF SOUNDS)

Use two hoops labelled with two sounds ie 'l' and 'a'.
 You could also use two ropes placed on the floor in the shape of a Venn diagram with a section in the middle for words containing both sounds.
 Give children cards or pictures with words containing these sounds.
 They have to place it in the right circle. Words with both sounds go in the intersection.

SONGS AND RHYMES

Listen to track 2 **Dans mon pays.** Mime the lyrics and ask the children to copy you.

Dans mon pays de France	In my country, France
Y a des baguettes comme ça (bis)	There are bread sticks like this
Et du fromage comme ça (bis)	And cheese like that.

Dans mon pays d'Espagne	In my country, Spain
Il y a du riz comme ça	There's rice
Et des poissons comme ça	And fish like that.

Dans mon pays d'Allemagne	In my country, Germany
Y a des saucisses comme ça (bis)	There are sausages like this
Des pommes de terre comme ça bis	And potatoes like that.

Dans mon pays de Grand Bretagne	In my country, Great Britain
Il y a du thé comme ça (bis)	There is tea like this
Et des biscuits comme ça (bis)	And biscuits like that.

The children work in pairs with multilink cubes. They take one cube every time they hear a certain word.
 How many cubes have they collected by the end of the song?

Later on, when the children are more familiar with the sounds, give them the lyrics so they can follow the words with their finger.

When the children are familiar with the song, distribute text cards to the children, one set of cards between 2 or 3 children which display some of the key words.

Listening to the song and looking at the lyrics on the screen, each group puts the cards in the order which the words are heard in the song.
